

Chiddingly Parish Council

Grants Policy for financial year 1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023.

Chiddingly Parish Council has a policy of making grants that contribute to the welfare of the parish community, for example by improving and supporting local facilities and groups.

These grants shall be subject to the following guidelines:

1. An overall limit to the value of grants in any one year will be determined and included in the budget setting for 2022-2023.
2. Applications for grants should be submitted to the Parish Council by 30th September 2021.
3. Applications for grants should be made via the Parish Council application form and should include appropriate financial information, the cost of the project and who will benefit.
4. Completed applications should be emailed to: clerk@chiddingly.gov.uk
5. Applications will then be reviewed by the full council at the parish council meeting in October 2021, with the aim of making final decisions subject to the following criteria:

Chiddingly Parish Council will not normally support:

- a. Political organisations or activities of a commercial nature.
- b. Major charities or organisations that do not have a local focus.
- c. Organisations who are generally funded by other Government authorities, unless for special projects not funded by Government authorities.
